

Excellent introduction to Hillary for any young reader. Surprisingly even handed and, while generally positive for Hillary, it also covers her failed healthcare initiative during Bill Clinton's presidency, her ill advised vote for the Iraq War and her loss to Obama in 2008. Lot's of related overviews including one on Eleanor Roosevelt, The Great Depression and other woman who have run for president (who knew that several woman ran in the late 1800's?).

I talk to my kids about politics and I try to be fair, although I do have a bias. What I like about this book is that it was positive and honest in an age appropriate manner. HRC is an exceptional person, that is clear in the book. But the book also hits on her failures and the impeachment of her husband. There is enough information to have a conversation but not presented in a sleazy way that would be inappropriate for children or biased.
