

Very confusing sentence why is a 6th grader who's gifted with 6th graders who are much older. What is much older & why are much older kids in 6th grade? Sorry that doesn't make sense. Then a few paragraphs later it states when he's in 7th grade he is a whole year younger than the rest of his peers. most kids are 5 when they start kindergarten so being 12 in 7th grade is the norm. She is so frustrated she doesn't even want to read it anymore. I guess we are reading a different book than the other reviewers. I'd rent it from the library before wasting your money.

Targets students ages 8-12. Challenging reading for that age group with concepts they may not always grasp. Very well written. Good coverage of important early years and influences. More suitable for ages 11 and up.
