

Mr. Parillo must have worked extremely hard on this book because it reminds me of visiting a church or museum in Italy. The more you look, the more you see. I had great expectations for this book, but was quite disappointed. The illustrations are cartoonish,

and only one page is devoted to Michaelangelo's actual work on the snowman. Is he in the stable? No-o-o.) So much more could have been done with this story, so much more! My 6 year old tried to act politely interested, but was as bored as I.
